#2	<p><b>PROPOSED INCOME TAX LEVY (RENEWAL)</b>  <b>NORTHWEST LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT</b> Shall an annual income tax of one percent on the earned income of individuals residing in the School District be imposed by the Edon Northwest Local School District to renew an income tax expiring at the end of 2020 for five (5) years, beginning January 1, 2021, for the purpose of providing for the current operating expenses of the School District.</p>	012-FLO-EDON;017-NWT;024/2-SUP
